# Setubandha Scholar Scheme – Round 2 Selection Process Instructions for Shortlisted Candidates Notification

12.11.2025

(Note: Previous notification F. No. CSU/Exam/ SSS/2025/365 dated 06/10/2025 published in University's website [www.sanskrit.nic.in](http://www.sanskrit.nic.in) regarding instructions for candidates shortlisted for Round 2 of the selection process under the Setubandha Scholar Scheme, Central Sanskrit University, New Delhi, stands cancelled due to administrative reasons.)

With reference to the F. No. 17-2/ Acd/CSU/ Academic/2024/722 dated 14 July 2025 and, F.No. 17-2/ Acd/CSU/ Academic/2024/1213 dated 10 October 2025, Central Sanskrit University hereby notifies the following instructions for candidates shortlisted for **Round 2** of the selection process under the **Setubandha Scholar Scheme** in the notification F.No. 17-2/ Acd/CSU/ Academic/2024/1051 and F.No. 17-2/ Acd/CSU/ Academic/2024/1310.

### 1. Written Examination

- i. The written examination shall be conducted in the concerned subject through offline mode only.
- ii. Duration of the examination: 3 hours
- iii. Maximum Marks: 100
- iv. The written examination is qualifying exam only.
- v. Qualifying Marks: 50
- vi. The mode of the paper shall be descriptive.
- vii. Syllabus structure is given in **Annexure I**.
- viii. Question Paper pattern is given in **Annexure II**.
- ix. The medium of examination shall be Sanskrit for all disciplines classified under Shastra studies. In cases where a discipline inherently requires a different language for academic or textual engagement, the medium shall be specified accordingly and shall remain discipline-specific as given in **Annexure III**.

## 2. Oral Examination

- i. Only candidates qualifying the written examination shall be eligible for the oral examination in the respective discipline.
- ii. The oral examination shall be conducted individually.

## 3. Merit List Criteria

- i. Merit list shall be prepared based on the **performance** in oral exams only.
- ii. The written exam serves as a **qualifying exam only**, whereas the oral exam will determine the merit.

## 4. Examination Schedule & Centre

- i. **Written Exam Date: 23<sup>rd</sup> November, 2025 (Sunday)**
- ii. **Written Exam Time: 10:00 AM to 1:00 PM.**
- iii. **Oral Exam Date: First or second week of January 2026 (Tentative)**
- iv. Both written and oral examinations shall be held at the **Centres designated** by Central Sanskrit University given in **Annexure IV**.
- v. Candidates who have been shortlisted are hereby instructed to indicate their choice of examination centre via the designated Google Form, accessible at: <https://forms.gle/ZgreCfuH7EEAVuqq6> **till 14 November 2025 (05:00 pm)**

ii.	Shastras that are thematically, philosophically, or pedagogically allied with the core subject shall also be part of the syllabus.
iii.	Shastric Aptitude and Research Aptitude are included in the syllabus.
iv.	Only complete texts are included in the syllabus. Candidates must ensure that they engage with the complete works; selected portions or summaries will not be accepted for examination purposes.

<b>PhD Level</b>	
i.	All major texts pertaining to the concerned subject, as studied at the postgraduate (PG) level, are included in the syllabus.
ii.	Shastras that are thematically, philosophically, or pedagogically allied with the core subject shall also be part of the syllabus.
iii.	Shastric Aptitude and Research Aptitude are included in the syllabus.
iv.	Only complete texts are included in the syllabus. Candidates must ensure that they engage with the complete works; selected portions or summaries will not be accepted for examination purposes.

<b>Important Note for Candidates applying in both PG &amp; PhD Level</b>	
The question paper will cover the full range of subjects within the individual group (titled 'Subject') given in the table in <i>Annexure III</i> . The scope of questions will not be restricted to the specific subject mentioned in the application by the candidate.
